Eligibility: This **\$500.00 Undergraduate Scholarship** is open to any FSU Panhellenic woman of exemplary moral character with the following criteria indicated below.

Criteria: The recipient must be an active undergraduate member in good standing of a National Panhellenic Conference sorority group.

- A cumulative 3.7 or higher GPA, having attained at least 60 academic credit hours
- Have taken no fewer than 12 hours per any semester at FSU (during Spring or Fall of any academic year)
- Have been an active member of at least one year in good standing of any FSU Panhellenic chapter which faces no disciplinary action
- Have completed service hours verifiable by a chapter officer or advisor

Requirements:

1. Submit proof of GPA (unofficial transcript)
2. Community Service and Philanthropy work with total hours for each
3. Recommendation Letter submitted by a local alumna or a chapter advisor (email)
4. A short essay on the meaning of “Wisdom” in 250 words or less
